Students must declare the minor in History no later than Autumn quarter of the senior year via Axess. Candidates for the minor in History must complete six courses, at least three of which must have a field or thematic focus. In addition, two of the six courses must be small-group in format (Stanford Introductory Seminars, Sources and Methods Seminars, departmental colloquia, and research seminars) and three of the six must be taught by Stanford History faculty.
